The luncheon will feature keynote speaker Chris Prochut, a former police commander whose own lived experience led him to become a nationally recognized mental health advocate and suicide prevention trainer. Mr. Prochut will be introduced by former Appleton Police Sergeant John Wallschlaeger, a local mental health pioneer responsible for bringing crisis intervention team (CIT) training to police departments throughout the Fox Valley.
